STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

Attendance/Tardy/skipping (out of area):

- 1) Students are expected to attend classes regularly and punctually. If student is determined to be truant according to Polk County School policy, a meeting will be scheduled parent/guardian to assist and provide support. If attendance continues to be an issue, it will be referred to district Social Worker and Truancy Officer.
- 2) Students <u>must</u> possess a teacher-issued pass to be out of the classroom, for any/all reasons, after the tardy bell.
- 3) Teachers will implement a pass-limiting policy in their class for each student.
- 4) Restrooms will be **closed** during certain transition times. Students must receive a pass from the teacher to use the restroom during instructional time.
- 5) Students will be issued a discipline consequence beginning on his/her 4th tardy to class, and for each tardy thereafter.
- 6) Students out of the classroom without a teacher-issued class will be considered out of area/skipping, and will be issued progressive disciplinary consequences for each offense.

Cell phones:

- 1) Student CELL PHONES/ EARBUDS must be turned off and secured in his/her clear book bag, upon entry to campus each day. Phones must remain in book bags throughout the day.
- 2) If a student is found to be in possession of cell phone, other than in the book bag, the cell phone will be confiscated and must be retrieved by a parent/legal guardian. The phone will not be returned to the student under any circumstances.
- 3) On the second violation, and every subsequent offense thereafter, in addition to phone confiscation, the student will be issued a progressive disciplinary consequence.

Dress code:

While on campus, students must be in proper dress code at all times.

- 1) Wear the appropriate grade-level color polo shirt or plain shirt in the designated colors per grade level (6th-light blue, 7th-dark gray, 8th-black).
- 2) Shirts must be completely tucked into pants at waistline.
- 3) Pants must be khaki or black, black jeans (no tears, rips, or designer logos).
- 4) Pants must be worn at top of hips (no "sagging"). A belt must be worn with pants.
- 5) A zippered jacket may be worn on colder days, but the wearing of a hoodie on the head is never allowed.
- 6) The student Id. must be displayed around the neck at all times, on a school lanyard (The first replacement Id is free; each subsequent replacement Id is \$5.00 each).
- 7) Only clear book bags are allowed on campus. Any other type bags will be confiscated and returned at the end of school day. Subsequent violations will result in progressive discipline.
- 8) Shoe wear- NO CROCS, FOAM RUNNERS, HOUSE SHOES, SANDALS, SLIDES.
