Dear Parent or Guardian,

One of the graduation requirements for a Florida standard high school diploma is to pass the Algebra 1 EOC or earn a passing comparative score.

There are several ways a student can meet the Algebra 1 Graduation Requirement:

- Pass the Algebra 1 EOC with a Level 3 or higher
  - Offered 4 times a year (Fall, Winter, Spring, Summer)

- Pass the Geometry EOC with a Level 3 or higher
  - Offered 4 times a year (Fall, Winter, Spring, Summer)

- Earn a 16 or higher on the ACT Math Subtest
  - Typically offered 7 times a year
  - <https://www.act.org/content/act/en-florida.html>
- Earn a 420 or higher on the SAT Math Subtest
  - Typically offered 7 times a year

- Earn a 430 or higher on the PSAT/NMSQT Math Subtest
  - Offered once a year
